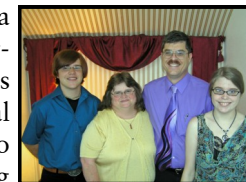

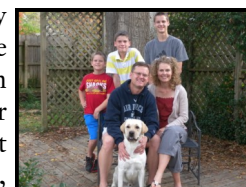


Serving as Deacons:



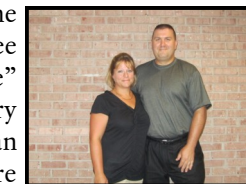
